AUDIT SCOPE:

The scope of this report covers Spruce 4 Rch (78,90), which has a surface of approximately 140 acres of conventional melons. Melons were observed during the inspection. The audit was based upon a sampling review of food safety documentation (FSMS, policies, and SOPs) and a field survey of the ranch operation and surrounding grounds (Ground history, adjacent land, fertilizer/crop nutrition, irrigation, crop protection and, field employee hygiene). Canal water is used on the Farm (Crops are sprinkler irrigated for germination and set and furrow irrigated throughout the growing and harvest cycle). Pesticide chemical recommendation is provided by a State licensed Pest Control Adviser. The final decision to spray and fertilizer is made by the grower. Chemicals and fertilizers were not stored on the farm on the day of the audit. Nutrien Ag Solutions is responsible for the crop protection sprays (water test were available for review). Joe A Ramirez was present for the farm inspection and review of the related food safety documentation. At the time of the inspection, there were no workers present on the farm. Growing season January to July. Northside of the farm- Baughman Rd/agricultural lands, Southside of the farm-Agricultural lands, Westside of the Farm-agricultural land, and Eastside of the farm- Agricultural lands.
